- open with the Lord God of Israel Being known and understood in the Tanach as "our Father" who loves us and provides for us and in doing so offers us Mercy and grace.
- The Talmud Bavli Sotah 14a states the Torah opens and closes with the grace of God.
 - Modern theologies teach the Lord has gone through some kind of transformation

$$\begin{matrix} \text{OT} & \longleftrightarrow & \text{NT} \\ (\text{works}) & & (\text{grace}) \end{matrix}$$

- Psalm 19, the Torah is restorative to the soul... How?
 - the word chesed (חסד) being translated as grace (NT) and lovingkindness (OT).
